**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO FILE OUT OF TIME**

On May 9, 2021, Respondent JUUL Labs, Inc. (“Respondent” or “JLI”) filed a Motion for Leave to File Out of Time (“Motion”). Respondent recites that under the Second Revised Scheduling Order issued in this case on March 4, 2021, the deadline for filing motions for *in camera* treatment of proposed trial exhibits, pursuant to Rule 3.45 of the FTC’s Rules of Practice, was May 7, 2021. 16 C.F.R. § 3.45. JLI seeks an extension until May 8, 2021.

JLI explains that due to technical difficulties in uploading an exhibit for JLI’s Motion for *In Camera* Treatment, JLI’s counsel was unable to successfully complete the filing until the morning of May 8, 2021, shortly after the May 7, 2021 deadline. JLI further states that Federal Trade Commission Complaint Counsel consents to this Motion.

Based on the foregoing, the Motion is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that Respondent JLI’s deadline for filing its Motion for *in camera* treatment under Rule 3.45 is extended to May 8, 2021.
