Dear Mr. Mashal:

This is in response to your request dated June 23, 2017, amended June 23, 2017, under the Freedom of Information Act seeking access to complaints filed against FleetCor, Fuelman and Comdata. In accordance with your amended request, we have searched our records from February 1, 2017 to June 23, 2017, the date we received your request.

We located approximately 51 consumer complaints. I am granting partial access to the consumer complaints. I am denying access to consumers' names and addresses, and any other identifying information found in the complaints. This information is exempt from release under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), because an individual's right to privacy outweighs the general public's interest in disclosure of personally identifying information (PII). See The Lakin Law Firm v. FTC, 352 F.3d 1122 (7th Cir. 2003). Please note that the complaints have not necessarily been verified by the FTC. Therefore, you should make your own judgment about relying on the information provided.

The Commission's fee regulations specify that fees less than \$25 will be waived. See 16 C.F.R. § 4.8(b)(4). Because the fees associated with the processing of your request did not exceed \$25, we have processed your request free of charge.

If you are not satisfied with this response to your request, you may appeal by writing to Freedom of Information Act Appeal, Office of the General Counsel, Federal Trade Commission, 600 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20580, within 90 days of the date of this letter. Please enclose a copy of your original request and a copy of this response.
